

Hunter, J. F. M. *Thinking About Sex and Love*. New York: St. Martin's, 1980.

The author addresses the moral considerations attached to sexual behavior in contemporary society; a philosophical inquiry into the theory and practice of personal sexual morality.

Jones, Clinton R. *Understanding Gay Relatives and Friends*. New York: Seabury, 1978.

The senior canon of Christ Church Cathedral, Hartford, has drawn on his secular training as a marriage, family, and sex therapist to provide eleven readable case studies, including a homosexual son, daughter, brother, sister, husband, wife, father, teacher, and clergyman, as well as a transvestite husband and a transsexual son.

Kelly, Gary F. *Sexuality: The Human Perspective*. Woodbury, N.Y.: Barron's, 1980.

An excellent college or young adult text, useful as a reference in a home library. Thirteen chapters are organized around four parts (Male/Female, Women/Men; Human Sexual Behavior; Dealing with Sexual Problems; Sex and Contemporary Society) and an appendix, "Resources in Human Sexuality."

McCary, James Leslie. *McCary's Human Sexuality*. 3rd ed. New York: Van Nostrand, 1978.

Since its first edition in 1967, this college textbook has become a standard source of sex education; twenty-one chapters are organized around six parts: introduction, the human sexual system, the sexual act, present-day sexual attitudes and behavior, sexual complications, and sex and society.

Reich, Warren T., ed. *Encyclopedia of Bioethics*. New York: Free Press, 1978.

Excellent articles with bibliographies include "Homosexuality," "Sex Therapy and Sex Research," "Sexual Behavior," "Sexual Development," "Sexual Ethics," and "Sexual Identity."

Vannoy, Russell. *Sex Without Love: A Philosophical Exploration*. Buffalo, N.Y.: Prometheus, 1980.

An analysis of the major issues of both sex and love; the book's thesis is that a sexual relationship between individuals who are not in love can be meaningful and fulfilling.

Verene, D. P., ed. *Sexual Love and Western Morality*. New York: Harper, 1972.

A philosophical anthology of major thinkers, from ancient to contemporary periods, on the nature of sex, the sexes, and sexual love.
